# Have you heard the threats to block federal funding to both private and public schools if they do not comply?

Schools, both private and public have been threatened to lose federal funding if they do not comply with the Biden administration's new interpretation of Title IX. Under the new interpretation, any student must be allowed to enter into any space in which they identify with or schools may risk losing federal funding. The new interpretation seeks to flip the traditional understanding of sex-segregated spaces. The new interpretation wants all schools that receive federal funds to provide open access to locker rooms, bathrooms, and sports based solely on the students' self-perceived gender identity.

The move to inforce this new interpretation has many negative consequences for all individuals, but is especially burdensome to educators. The financial pipeline that federal funding provides to schools is worth millions, even billions in some states. Prior to 2020, approximately 11% of K-12 public education funding was provided from federal funds. These federal funds primarily support child nutrition, students from low-income households, and students with disabilities. In September 2021, the U.S. Department of Education provided the state of North Carolina \$12 billion in American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ARP ESSER) funds.

Some states have already begun the fight against the Biden administration's re-interpretation of Title IX. As of this month, more than 20 attorneys general sued the Biden administration sighting how the policy could potentially affect many school programs such as the meal/nutrition programs.

Please pray for the Lord to guide our lawmakers and politicians to make the right decisions for our K-12 aged children.
